Step 1: Praise & Thanksgiving

Worship & Invitational Prayers

†In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Shout joyfully to the Lord, all you lands; serve the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful song. Know that the Lord is God, He made us, we belong to him, we are his people, the flock he shepherds. Enter his gates with thanksgiving, His courts with praise.

Give thanks to him, bless his name; good indeed is the Lord,

His mercy endures forever,

Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord; cry out to the rock of our salvation.

Recitation of Baptismal Vows

Prayer for Protection to Saint Michael the Archangel

Final Prayers for Protection

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit! As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom his love commits me here, ever this day be at my side, to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen.

Step 4: Renunciations & Reclamation

We are now ready for battle. Take out your homework packet. We are going to say the prayers of renunciation, to ask the Lord to break Satan's hold over every stronghold or area of bondage that may exist in our lives. Like every other prayer we have said today, I want you to pray these aloud because you need to hear that the legal right the Devil has in your life is broken by the power of God. (If you experience any problems while praying these renunciation prayers, please ask for the deliverance leader's help. Note when it happened, if possible, as that may help the deliverance leader isolate the issue when he prays over you.)

#1. Renouncing Unforgiveness

First, you should pull out homework list #1 (unforgiveness). Repeat the first line of this prayer for each person on that first homework list. Then finish saying aloud the remainder.

In the name of Jesus Christ, I forgive (person's name) for (what they did to you). I renounce any hold that Satan has on my life because of my lack of forgiveness. Oh, Merciful Father, I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that you would release me from this bondage and make me a vessel of Your perfect love. "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you." I must "Bear with each other and forgive one another if [I have] a grievance against someone." I must "Forgive as the Lord forgave [me]." For when St. Peter asked, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive him? As many as seven times?" You answered him, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times." I must remember, oh Lord, that you "forgave [me] my entire debt [of sin] because [I] begged you to. Should [I] not have had pity on [others], as You had pity on [me]?" Help me to forgive these people, oh Lord. Please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of my unforgiveness towards these individuals and free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Thank you, Lord, for hearing my prayer! †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#2. Renouncing Judgments

Next, you should pull out homework list #2 (judgments). Repeat the first line of this prayer for each person on that second homework list. Then finish saying aloud the remainder.

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce and release any judgments I have rendered against (person's name) for (what they did). I renounce any hold that Satan has on my life because of these judgments. Oh, Merciful Father, I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that you would release me from this bondage and teach me how to drop every rock of judgment in my hands that I desired to stone others with. You and You alone, oh Lord, are the Rock of Judgment, and I put my trust in Your perfect justice and unfathomable mercy. For it is written: "Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven." I now ask, oh Lord, that you would remove all evil spirits attached to me because of these judgments I held towards these individuals and that you would free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#3. Renouncing the Occult

Next, you should pull out homework list #3 (occult activities and non-Christian practices) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce the following occult activities and non-Christian practices which I have willfully participated in during the course of my life: (recite your entire list). Forgive me, oh Lord, for having committed these grave and detestable sins! For they are an abomination before Your righteous eyes, oh Sovereign Lord. I renounce any hold that Satan has on my life because of these sinful actions. Oh, Merciful Father, I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that you would release me from this bondage and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of these wicked practices. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

If you have participated in Satanic rituals (willingly or unwillingly), pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I fully renounce ever having participated willingly or unwillingly in any Satanic ritual or practice of any kind during my life. I renounce ever having signed my name over in any way to Satan, or ever having my name signed over to Satan for me. I renounce any ceremony where I may have been wed or consecrated to Satan. I renounce any and all covenants or pacts with Satan that I made myself, or that were made for me. I renounce ever giving my blood, or having my blood taken without my consent, in the service of the kingdom of darkness. I renounce ever eating human flesh or blood for Satanic worship. And I renounce any and all guardians and Satanic parents that were assigned to me.

Oh Lord, hear my prayer! Deliver me from my foes, for they are too great for me to defeat alone! I announce in your Divine hearing, oh Sovereign God, that my name is written in the Book of Life, that I am the Bride of Christ and a partaker of His New Covenant, that I trust and partake only in the shed blood of my Lord, Jesus Christ, through the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist. God is my Father, the Lord Jesus is my King and Savior, the Holy Spirit is my Guardian by which I am sealed, and the Virgin Mary is my Blessed Mother and Queen! (I also renounce the following Satanic practices I participated in willingly or unwillingly: recite your list, if it differs from what has already been renounced above.)

Forgive me, oh Lord, for having committed these grave and detestable sins! For they are an abomination before Your righteous eyes, oh Sovereign Lord. I renounce any hold that Satan has on my life because of these sinful actions. I renounce any hold that Satan has on my life because of the sins and Satanic rituals that may have been imposed upon me without my consent! Oh, Merciful Father, I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that you would release me from this terrible bondage and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of these wicked practices. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#4. Renouncing Sexual Sin

Next, you should pull out homework list #4 (sexual sin). For each person on that list, pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any legal right that Satan has to me because of the sexual sins I committed with (<u>name each person on your list</u>). I repent of the impurity, sexual sin, and debauchery in which I have indulged! Thoroughly wash away my guilt, and from my sin cleanse me! For you have said in your Word, oh Lord, "Their sins and their evildoing I will remember no more." Put my willful sins, the sins of my youth, as far away from your eyes as the east is from the west! Oh, Merciful Father, I ask that you would release me from this bondage and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of my sexual sins. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#5. Renouncing Broken Promises

Next, you should pull out homework list #5 (broken contracts, covenants, oaths, and vows) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any legal right that Satan has to me because of the following covenants, oaths, and vows that I willfully broke and failed to keep during the course of my life: (recite your entire list). Oh Lord, help me going forward to always keep my word, for in the one who does this is the love of God truly perfected, and by this, others may know that I am in Him! Let my mouth, oh Sovereign King, never lead me into sin, for as it is written: "When you make a vow to the Lord, your God, you shall not delay in fulfilling it; for the Lord, your God, will surely require it of you and you will be held guilty... But whatever your tongue utters you must be careful to do, just as you freely vowed to the Lord, your God, with your own mouth." Oh, Merciful Father, I ask that you would release me from all bondage due to my broken words and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of my carelessness. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#6. Renouncing Pride

Next, you should pull out homework list #6 (pride) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce the sin of pride, which the Catechism defines as "an inordinate self-esteem or self-love" that "seeks attention and honor and sets oneself in competition with God." I renounce all arrogance, boastfulness, competitiveness, conceit, egotism, self-centeredness, self-glorification, self-righteousness, selfishness, vainglory, and vanity. I renounce any time that I have set myself internally or externally against the Magisterium and the teaching authority of the Church, as if I know better than God. For the Lord opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble! When pride comes, then also comes disgrace! But with humility comes wisdom. Fill my heart with it! For there is more hope for a fool than for a person who is wise in his own eyes! So let me do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but rather, in righteous humility, let me value others above myself!

Specifically, I renounce the following things that I have been prideful of in my life: (recite your entire list). Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall! Better to be lowly in spirit along with the oppressed than to share plunder with the proud! For the Lord detests all the proud of heart. As it is written, we should "be sure of this: they will not go unpunished."

Oh, Merciful Father, I ask that you would release me from all bondage due to my pride and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of it. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#7. Renouncing Rebellion

Next, you should pull out homework list #7 (rebellion) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce all rebellion in my life: (recite your entire list). For it is written in the first book of Samuel that "rebellion is like the sin of divination," and the Catechism defines divination as "recourse to (or asking the help of) Satan or demons." Only the wicked pursue rebellion! A merciless messenger is sent against them, and they dwell in a parched land, in a desert! Oh Lord, let me be subordinate to the higher authorities in my life, for there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been established by God. Therefore, whoever resists authority opposes what God has appointed, and those who oppose it will bring judgment upon themselves. And the Lord Himself said, "If you love me, you will keep my commandments." Let me be like our Blessed Mother, who when the Archangel Gabriel approached her, humbly submitted to God's will! Foster the virtue of obedience in my heart, oh Sovereign God! For "a single instant passed under simple obedience is immeasurably more valuable in the sight of God than an entire day spent in the most sublime contemplation."

Merciful Father, I ask that you would release me from all bondage due to my rebellion and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of it. Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life. Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#8. Renouncing Thinking Errors, Self-Deceptions, and Self-Defense Behaviors

Next, you should pull out homework list #8 (thinking errors, self-deceptions, and self-defense behaviors). But before we renounce the items on that list, we should pray the following:

Litany of Who I Am in Christ

In the name of the Father, and of the Son †, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

I am Accepted...

I have been adopted as God's child (Eph. 1:5). I am accepted.

I am a child of God; God is my spiritual Father (Jn. 1:12; Rom. 8:14, 15; Gal. 3:26; 4:6). I am accepted.

I am a child of God and one in Christ (Gal. 3:26, 28). I am accepted.

I am an heir of God since I am a child of God (Gal. 4:6, 7). I am accepted.

I am a joint heir with Christ, sharing His inheritance with Him (Rom. 8:17). I am accepted.

I am united to the Lord and am one spirit with Him (1 Cor. 6:17). I am accepted.

I have been bought with a price; I belong to God (1 Cor. 6:19, 20). I am accepted.

I am a member of Christ's body (1 Cor. 12:27; Eph. 5:30). I am accepted.

I am a fellow citizen with the rest of God's family (Eph. 2:19). I am accepted.

I am a member of God's household (Eph. 2:19). I am accepted.

I am Christ's friend (Jn. 15:15). I am accepted.

I am an expression of the life of Christ because He is my life (Col. 3:4). I am accepted.

I am chosen of God, holy and dearly loved (Col. 3:12; 1 Thes. 1:4). I am accepted.

I am a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17). I am accepted.

I am holy (Eph. 1:1; 1 Cor. 1:2; Phil. 1:1; Col. 1:2). I am accepted.

I have access to God through the Holy Spirit (Eph. 2:18). I am accepted.

I am qualified to share in the inheritance of the saints (Col. 1:12). I am accepted.

I am redeemed (Col. 1:14). I am accepted.

I have fullness of life in Christ (Col. 2:10). I am accepted.

I am Secure...

I am in Jesus Christ and thus free from condemnation (Rom. 8:1, 2). I am secure.

I cannot be separated from the love of God (Rom. 8:35-39). I am secure.

I have been established, anointed, and sealed by God (2 Cor. 1:21, 22). *I am secure*.

I am hidden with Christ in God (Col. 3:3). I am secure.

I am a child of light and not of darkness (1 Thes. 5:5). I am secure.

I am confident that the good work that God has begun in me will be perfected (Phil. 1:6). I am secure.

I am a citizen of heaven (Phil. 3:20; Eph. 2:6). I am secure.

I have not been given a spirit of timidity or fear but of power, love, and self-discipline (2 Tim. 1:7). I am secure.

I am born of God, and the Evil One cannot touch me unless I let him or unless God allows it (1 Jn. 5:18). *I am secure*.

I am Significant...

I am the salt and light of the earth (Matt. 5:13, 14). I am significant.

I am a branch of the true vine, a channel of Christ's life (Jn. 15:1, 5). I am significant.

I am chosen and appointed by Christ to bear His fruit (Jn. 15:16). I am significant.

I am a holy partaker of a heavenly calling (Heb. 3:1). *I am significant*.

I am a partaker of Christ; I share in His life (Heb. 3:14). I am significant.

I am a personal witness of Christ (Acts 1:8). I am significant.

I am a temple, a dwelling place, of God. His Spirit and life dwell in me (1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19). I am significant.

I am reconciled to God and I am a messenger of conciliation (Mt 5:24; Rom 12:19). I am significant.

I am God's co-worker (2 Cor. 6:1; 1 Cor. 3:9). I am significant.

I am seated with Christ in the heavenly realm (Eph. 2:6). I am significant.

I am God's workmanship-His handiwork-born anew in Christ to do His work (Eph. 2:10). I am significant.

I may approach God with freedom and confidence (Eph. 3:12). I am significant.

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me (Phil. 4:13). *I am significant*.

I am one of God's living stones, being built up in Christ as a spiritual house (1 Pet. 2:5). I am significant.

I am a member of a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, and a people for God's own possession (1 Pet. 2:9, 10). *I am significant*.

I am an alien and stranger to this world in which I temporarily live (1 Pet. 2:11). I am significant.

I am an enemy of the devil (1 Pet. 5:8). I am significant.

I am a child of God and I will resemble Christ when He returns (1 Jn. 3:1, 2). I am significant.

I am in His Trusting Arms...

I am secure knowing that God is not a liar, but keeps His promises (Jos. 21:45; Rom. 15:8; 2 Pet. 1:4). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am promised God's grace and mercy to help me in time of need (Heb. 4:16). I am in His Trusting Arms.

I am promised that God will not allow me to be tempted beyond my strength (1 Cor. 10:13). *I am in His Trusting*Arms

I am promised that God will always provide me a way of escape from temptation (1 Cor. 10:13). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am promised that all things work together for good (Rom. 8:28). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am promised that I will be cleansed of sin when I confess (1 Jn. 1:9). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am promised victory through our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am promised eternal life when I remain in God's friendship (Jn. 10:27, 28; Mk. 16:16; Matt. 24:13). *I am in His Trusting Arms*.

I am not the great "I am" (Ex. 3:14; Jn. 8:24,28,58), but by the grace of God, I am what I am (1 Cor. 15:10).

Thank You Lord for what I am in Christ. Help me to realize all that I am so that I may glorify you in all the ways of my life. **Amen.**

Dear Heavenly Father. I know that you desire truth in the inner self and that facing this truth is the way of liberation (John 8:32). I acknowledge that I have been deceived by the father of lies (John 8:44) and that I have deceived myself (I John 1:8). I pray in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, strengthened by the intercessions of the Immaculate Virgin Mary, Mother of God, Blessed Michael the Archangel, Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, Padre Pio of Pietrelcina, Gordius, Dymphna, Benedict of Nursia, Bruno, Rita of Cascia, Lucian, Marcian, Margaret of Fontana, Quirinus of Sescia, Ubaldo Baldassini, Lucy Bufalari, Teresa of Avila, Bernadette of Lourdes, Agrippina of Rome, Amabilis of Auvergne, Andrew of Segni, Columba of Rieti, Cyriacus the Martyr, Demetrius of Sermium, Denis of Paris, Dionysius the Aeropagite, Margaret of Antioch, Peter the Exorcist, and Vincent de Paul, of my Patron Saint and my Guardian Angel, and all the Saints and Angels of Heaven, and powerful in the holy authority of His blessed Name, that you, heavenly Father, will rebuke all deceiving spirits by virtue of the shed blood and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ.

And since by faith I have received you into my life and am now seated with Christ in the heavenlies (Ephesians 2:6), I renounce the following thinking errors, self-deceptions, and self-defense behaviors that I have been deceived by throughout my earthly days: (recite your entire list). I renounce any hold that these lies have had over me. I renounce any bondage. Forgive me, oh Lord, for straying from the Truth. Like Pontius Pilate before me, who asked you face-to-face, "What is truth?" even as he stared Truth right in the eyes, my own ego and pride and self-centeredness have kept me focused on self-deceptions and lies instead of the One who stands before me! You are the Truth, oh Lord! You speak the truth! You, and you alone, declare what is right! Help me to know the Truth, oh Lord, for it shall set me free! For it is written: woe to those who call evil good and good evil, who put darkness for light and light for darkness, who put bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! I commit myself to know You and to follow Your Truth from now on, O Sovereign Lord.

I ask you now to "search me, O God, and know my heart: try me and know my anxious thoughts; and see if there be any hurtful way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way." I ask in the name of Jesus Christ that you would release me from these thinking errors and self-defense behaviors and that you would please remove all evil spirits attached to me because of these deceptions in my life. I break all agreements that I have made with the enemy of my soul concerning myself. I am not who Satan says I am, nor am I who others (or even myself) have said that I am! I ask you Father to command all deceiving spirits to depart from me. Oh, Merciful King, who rules from the holy mountain of Zion, hear my prayer! Free me from all influence of the demonic realm in my life because of any and all deceptions or thinking errors. In the name of Jesus Christ, send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#9. Sins/Traumas Perpetrated on Me by Others or through Events

Next, you should pull out homework list #9 (sins/traumas perpetrated on me) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any legal rights that the demonic kingdom may have over me because of any sinful, harmful, traumatic, or criminal act that was perpetrated on me by another person or through a traumatic event during my life: (recite your entire list of controlling or manipulative or abusive relationships, molestations, rapes, or other traumas that you have suffered). I know, oh Lord, that all things work for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose! And I forgive those who have trespassed against me. And even though I have walked through the valley of the shadow of death, I know that you are always with me; you restore my soul; to still waters, Lord, you lead me. Please free me, oh Merciful Father, from all demonic influence that might exist in my life because of what others have done to me, knowingly or unknowingly. Please

send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Thank you for hearing my prayer! †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#10. Idolatry

Next, you should pull out homework list #10 (idolatry) and pray the following:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any idol that I have erected in my own life, any person or thing that has taken the place of God in my heart, that I consider to be more important than You, oh Lord: (recite your entire list). Please forgive me for setting any person or thing above You in my life. Lord, there is no one who can take your place. You are my Creator, the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the One who made all things, who is everlasting to everlasting! Help me, oh Lord, to always center my heart in You, when I arise first thing in the morning until I lay down my head after the evening's song. You alone, oh Merciful King, are worthy of honor and worship, so I praise Your name, which is above all names. You are the Lord of my life! Send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#11. Renouncing Areas of Bondage

Next, you should pull out homework list #11 (other areas of bondage) and pray the following, if they apply to you.

For abortion:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce the abortion(s) that I committed in the past and the willful choice to forfeit the precious life (lives) of my own child(ren). Please forgive me, oh Lord, for failing to care for my baby(ies). I now give this child (these children) into your loving and tender arms, that You might care for them forever in Heaven. Oh, Merciful Father, please remove all demonic attachments and sever all legal rights that Satan has over my life because of my grave sin(s), and send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Help me to not only forgive myself in all this, but to also forgive those who were involved in this sin (i.e. the doctor, spouse, lover, or anyone else who may have helped me in carrying out this act). Thank you, Lord, for restoring in me a parent's loving and selfless heart, that I might be filled with the same boundless love that pours out from the heart of our Father in Heaven! †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

For any other general area of bondage not already covered in this deliverance session such as addictions, excessive mourning of the dead, habitual sins, or unconfessed sins (use the giant list of sins in the homework packet):

Finally, oh, Lord, in the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any legal right that Satan may have over me due to the following areas of bondage that I have struggled with during my life: (recite your entire list of addictions, habitual sins, and other strongholds you have struggled with in life). Please break the power of the Evil One over my life in these specific areas, oh Sovereign King, and send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Thank you, Lord, for setting me free from the shackles of sin and Satan! You are God! And who among the Heavens is like you? †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#12. Bondages Common to All

Finally, everyone should pray the following renunciation prayers.

For ancestral sins:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce the legal right Satan may have in my life due to ancestral or generational sins. Oh Lord, please free me from this bondage—break these generational curses and free me from this spiritual slavery! For as it is written, I was "called to be free," so set loose my chains of bondage, oh King of Kings, that I might serve others humbly in love, loving my neighbor as I love myself! I humbly ask that you would free me from all demonic influence because of any ancestral sins. In the name of Jesus Christ, send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Thank you for hearing my prayer! †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the

Holy Spirit. Amen.

For curses and spells:

In the name of Jesus Christ, I renounce any legal right Satan has over my life because of any curse that has been put over me by myself or another person, whether I am aware of it or not. I ask, oh Lord, that you would sever the wicked power that has oppressed me due to any word-curses, spells, hexes, the Evil Eye, magical incantations, sorceries, divinations, evil wishes and desires, hereditary seals, or any other form of external Satanic bondage placed on me by another person or demon. For you, oh Lord, have been seated in the right hand of the Heavens, far above every demon—every principality, authority, power, and dominion—and every name that is named not only in this age but also in the one to come! For my struggle is not with flesh and blood but with the principalities, with the powers, with the world rulers of this present darkness, with the evil spirits in the Heavens. And it is you, oh Lord, not myself, whom I draw my strength, from your mighty power! I humbly ask that you would free me from all demonic influence of this kind. Please send your Holy Angels to seize every demon and vanquish them to the foot of your cross, that they might receive your immediate judgment. Thank you for hearing my prayer! †In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

The Renunciation Ritual

Now we will perform the renunciation ritual. This ritual is merely a visible reminder for you in the future that you have confessed these sins, renounced Satan's claim in your life because of them, and reclaimed every last area of bondage that the Devil has been forced to abandon. The value of burning this paper filled with sins is to give a strong visual to yourself that your sins are gone—they have truly been washed away by the Blood of the Lamb, "so far...removed...from us" by God "as far as the east is from the west," and no longer exist (Psalm 103:12). It also helps to visualize the sins being burned up as an aid to help you renounce the sins and to remove from yourself any attachment to them. This is especially useful later on down the road, when the Devil will come and try to cause you to doubt the actions that you previously took during this deliverance. (And he most certainly will!) For example, it is very common to hear the Evil One visiting former clients weeks or months after their deliverance session, trying to convince them with his lies, like: "You didn't really forgive Susan! See—you're still angry about it!" Or his old line from Genesis, "Did you *really* renounce those Tarot cards during that deliverance?" Satan loves to cause us to doubt ourselves and God. (He tried to do this to Jesus in the wilderness.) We have to be careful of this.

†In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Our Father, who art in Heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on Earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. *Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.*

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit! As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

(Sprinkle a few drops of holy water on each page of your homework lists, lightly crumple them up, and then <u>safely</u> set these papers on fire. When the paper is consumed and the fire is out, pray the following:)

Thank you, Heavenly Father, for forgiving me. With the destruction of these lists, I give up any and all attachment to the sins listed and to all sin. I give myself permission to forgive myself. I give up these sins to you, Lord, and I know that the Blood of Christ Jesus cleanses me. I am made pure and as white as snow by your forgiveness, love, and mercy through the Cross. Thank you for loving me enough to forgive me and to cleanse me of all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). Stoop beneath the all-powerful Hand of God; tremble and flee when we invoke the Holy and terrible Name of Jesus, this Name which causes hell to tremble, this Name to which the Virtues, Powers, and Dominations of Heaven are humbly submissive, this Name which the Cherubim and Seraphim praise unceasingly repeating: Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord, the God of

Hosts.

V. O Lord, hear my prayer.

R. And let my cry come unto Thee.

V. May the Lord be with thee.

R. And with thy spirit.

Let us pray. God of Heaven, God of Earth, God of Angels, God of Archangels, God of Patriarchs, God of Prophets, God of Apostles, God of Martyrs, God of Confessors, God of Virgins, God who has power to give life after death and rest after work: because there is no other God than Thee and there can be no other, for Thou art the Creator of all things, visible and invisible, of Whose reign there shall be no end, we humbly prostrate ourselves before Thy glorious Majesty and we beseech Thee to deliver us by Thy power from all the tyranny of the infernal spirits, from their snares, their lies and their furious wickedness. Deign, O Lord, to grant us Thy powerful protection and to keep us safe and sound. We beseech Thee through Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.

V. From the snares of the Devil,

R. Deliver us, O Lord.

V. That Thy Church may serve Thee in peace and liberty:

R. We beseech Thee to hear us.

V. That Thou may crush down all enemies of Thy Church:

R. We beseech Thee to hear us.

†In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. (Sprinkle holy water at feet.)

Step 7: Our Father's Blessing

Let us praise God with joy and thanksgiving for what He has accomplished in us today. Then we shall ask Him for a special blessing, to strengthen us as we go forth in the peace of God with a newfound joy and freedom.

Remember: one must be willing to resign one's self to God's Divine Perfect Will. If you are not delivered entirely after this deliverance session ends, you must continue seeking out God's will for your life. It is likely that the suffering you are experiencing is being used for some good purpose in your life. Maybe it's to teach you something, maybe God is permitting you to struggle for a long time to see if you are serious about truly repenting, or maybe there is a particular person God wants to pray over you for the demons to finally leave (perhaps because that person also bears an important message that you need to hear). But whatever the case may be, trust in God and accept that this session was not in vain. Your prayers have been heard by the Lord. He will provide all that you need to bear this particular cross until the timing for your full deliverance is right.

Order for the Blessing of the Sick (Shorter Form)

Our help is in the name of the Lord.

Who made Heaven and Earth.

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to Mark (5:1-3, 6-8, 18-19). *Glory to you, O Lord.*

"They came to the other side of the sea, to the territory of the Gerasenes. When [Jesus] got out of the boat, at once a man from the tombs who had an unclean spirit met him. The man had been dwelling among the tombs, and no one could restrain him any longer, even with a chain. In fact, he had frequently been bound with shackles and chains, but the chains had been pulled apart by him and the shackles smashed, and no one was strong enough to subdue him. Night and day among the tombs and on the hillsides he was always crying out and bruising himself with stones. Catching sight of Jesus from a distance, he ran up and prostrated himself before him, crying out in a loud voice, 'What have you to do with me, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I adjure you by God, do not torment me!' ([Jesus] had been saying to him, 'Unclean spirit, come out of the man!') [Jesus] asked him, 'What is your name?' [The man] replied, 'Legion is my name. There are many of us.' And he pleaded earnestly with [Jesus] not to drive them away from that territory."

"Now a large herd of swine was feeding there on the hillside. And they pleaded with him, 'Send us into the swine. Let us enter them.' And [Jesus] let them, and the unclean spirits came out and entered the swine. The herd of about two thousand rushed down a steep bank into the sea, where they were drowned. The swineherds ran away and reported the incident in the town and throughout the countryside. And people came out to see what had happened. As they approached Jesus, they caught sight of the man who had been possessed by Legion, sitting there clothed and in his right mind. And they were seized with fear. Those who witnessed the incident explained to them what had happened to the possessed man and to the swine. Then they began to beg [Jesus] to leave their district. As he was getting into the boat, the man who had been possessed pleaded to remain with him. But [Jesus] would not permit him but told him instead, 'Go home to your family and announce to them all that the Lord in his pity has done for you.' Then the man went off and began to proclaim in the Decapolis what Jesus had done for him; and all were amazed."

The Gospel of the Lord.

Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

(If needed, the deliverance counselor may trace the sign of the cross on the client's forehead while praying:)

Lord and Father, almighty and eternal God, by your blessing you give us strength and support in our frailty: turn with kindness toward your servant, N. Free him/her from all illness and restore him/her to health, so that in the sure knowledge of your goodness he/she will gratefully bless your Holy Name.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. †In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen.
